ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Allasso recognises the impact its work has on the environment and regards effective sustainable, environmental management as an integral part of its business.

The objective of this policy is to ensure that all activities are undertaken, to effectively manage adverse environmental impacts. Through the setting of Objectives and Targets, environmental impacts will be managed and reduced.

This policy statement is supported by the Board of Directors and will be reviewed annually.

The overall responsibility for Environmental resides with the Allasso Board of Directors, who will allocate the necessary competent resources to ensure full implementation of the policy.

Allasso will:

- Establish responsibilities for environmental management
- Comply with applicable legislation, industry codes of practice and other requirements related to our aspects of our work, as a minimum level of environmental performance
- Audit and review our processes and systems to ensure the continuing effectiveness and continual improvement Environmental Management
- Monitor and report performance and take corrective actions as necessary
- Minimise pollution, dust, noise, vibration and other nuisance
- Use sustainable construction methods and materials wherever practical
- Carry out environmental enhancements where appropriate
- Minimise waste to landfill and maximise recycling
- Encourage clients to use sustainable construction methods and materials
- Avoid or minimise disruption and damage to local habitats
- Efficiently manage materials and plant to avoid or minimise pollution
- Use materials and energy as efficiently as practicable
- Consult and work with all relevant stakeholders recognising a shared responsibility for environmental improvement and fostering a joint approach with our clients, suppliers and contractors
- Communicate appropriate environmental information to all employees, clients, stakeholders and other interested parties.
